Information Services (IS) update

The vision of IS Committee at Hindu Community and Cultural Center (HCCC) is to serve the ever-increasing devotee community in an efficient way and to enhance the devotee experience in every aspect of their interactions with the Shiva-Vishnu Temple. The dedicated efforts of volunteers at HCCC in re-launching and continually enhancing the www.livermoretemple.org Web site are directed towards providing efficient services to the large devotee population. The website is serving the devotees in three different ways:

1. Provide information to the devotee, directly through the interaction with the website.
2. Support the HCCC's administrators and managers with software tools to serve the devotees efficiently.
3. Provide infrastructure tools to HCCC's management to manage the finances and other essential services.

It is our goal to make this website as simple and comprehensive as possible to make the devotee experience a pleasurable one. We explore the features of the website that make the devotee experience a pleasant process.

Home page: The home page provides important information about temple timings, weather at Livermore, Rahukalam, Yamagandam, Gulikakalam for the day. Pooja and event schedules for the day and next seven days are displayed prominently on the main page. Details about major upcoming events, along with the schedules and the ability to sponsor for the special events, are provided through banner links on the home page. Devotees can also subscribe to the e-mail list of the HCCC, which would enable the devotees to get latest and important information about special poojas and events conducted in the temple. The temple sends out a weekly email to over 17,000 devotees informing them of upcoming events in the temple.

Contact Information: Driving directions to the temple and ability to plan a trip from the devotee's home (or office) to temple using public transportation is provided under the Contact Information section. This page also provides contact information (E-mail and phone) of Executive Committee members responsible for various services provided by the temple, thus enabling the devotee to contact the respective member directly. Devotees can also send their suggestions/recommendations for improving the services in the temple through a Feedback form.

General information: This section of the web site provides information about yearly schedule of festivities and other important events at the temple sorted by month, regular daily pooja schedules for all the deities in the temple; architectural layout of all the deities, along with pertinent information about the deity, priests, major festivals and events, slokas and stotras; online version of temple's newsletter (Paschima Vani - published 6 times a year, see the Newsletter link). The pooja services that are offered by the temple are provided in this section, to make the devotee aware of the procedures of the pooja and the materials that are needed for performing the pooja. Information about all the priests, along with their deity specialization and their photos, is published on the web site, which enhances the communication between a devotee and the priest. A photo album section provides digital images of the events and poojas that are conducted in the temple.

Information about Youth and Education (dealing with Hindu teachings and Culture) and Human Services (programs to reach out to the community) activities of HCCC is provided.

Poojas/Festivals: Devotees can make donation for a selected festival/purpose or make a suggested donation for a pooja (that is to be performed in the Temple) online through the website, in the process saving valuable time when the devotee visits the Temple. If the devotee requests (through the website) for a pooja that is to be performed at the temple, an e-mail would be sent to the manager(s) informing them about the pooja request by a devotee so as to make sure that the priests are informed accordingly. Devotees can also sponsor for festivals and special events, through the website. Devotees, who sponsored for annual abhisheka, would get an e-mail in advance about the poojas that are performed.

In addition to the above, a devotee can get his/her donation/pooja transaction history (either for personal use or for record keeping for tax related purposes) from the temple website.

Update from the Steering Committee (SC) meeting - May 18th, 2003

The quarterly meeting of the Temple Steering Committee took place on Sunday, May 18th 2003. Here are some important points from the meeting:

- ❖ The 2003 Election results for the new Board of Directors and Executive Committee was approved. In addition, the nomination of Lingagoud Memula (for 1 year) as a replacement for a vacant Board of Director position (resignation of Subadra Subramanian) was also approved.
- ❖ Priest selection committee and Master Plan committee have been approved and have started their meetings.
- ❖ Chairman Shiv Mehta informed the SC that he would be appointing an Ad Hoc committee to review and recommend the TEMPLE OPERATING GUIDELINES.

UPAKARMA NIRNAYA

This year, Yajur Upakarma occurs a little earlier than usual i.e on Sunday, July 13th. The explanation for this is given below.

As Guru, Sukra Moudya and Simha Guru doshas are covered in both Sravana and Bhadrapada months, we can not conduct the Upakarma Samskara during these months. In this situation, we can perform the Upakarma Samskara during the Ashadha month as per the pramana given below:

AdyayoPakarma Karthavya yogyath, Pravrun Masau Ka Cha Doshena yuktav cheth, Aashdha maase kurvanthi – Nirnaya Sindh.

Because of Sravan & Bhadrapada are with Guru, Sukra moundhya dosha, the upakarma can be performed in the month of Ashadha. Some of the Suthra karaas (Sri Vaikhanasa Kalpa Sutram) mention the Aashadha upakarma also. There is no worry in conducting the upakarma even for new upanayana vatus when Sravana and Bhadrapada months are shadowed with these doshas like, Guru, Sukra moudhyas and simha Guru dosha.

Those devotees who are unable to perform the Upakarma in the month of Aashada (July 13) can contact the temple for the Upakarma after the required Prayaschitta is performed in the month of Sravana (Aug 11).

Some of the forthcoming updates to the website, which would further enhance the devotee experience with the temple are:

1. Display of updated information about schedules and programs in the Temple through plasma and projection screens. These displays would be provided at strategic locations within the Temple.
2. Live Webcasting of special functions in the Temple and an ability to watch the temple functions through your browser at your own convenience.
3. Automated Credit Card and Check processing facility.
4. Ability for the devotee to perform all transactions (pooja booking, donations, laddu, etc.) with one single donation transaction.

The tools inside our website are used extensively by our administration staff to serve the devotee in an efficient manner. Manager can schedule a pooja (either in the temple or at the devotee's home/office) for the devotee, while getting the information from the devotee. In the future, we plan to empower the devotee with this kind of tools directly so that we can minimize the administration staff overhead for normal operations.

Managerial Support Information: HCCC Board of Directors and Executive Committee members get the latest information about temple revenues, priest schedules, donation details and other information that would help them manage the devotee services and make improvements in the services offered by the temple. HCCC management team has got flexible and efficient web based application to manage day-to-day activities of the Temple.

All the above services and facilities are made possible by the generous donations from ardent devotees, which have been used in building the necessary infrastructure for the management of computer systems. HCCC has a professionally managed computer center that is connected to the Internet through a high-speed T1 connection (which also provides the voice communication channels). The computer center hosts a Web Server, Database Server, E-mail Server and these are connected to the external world through a Firewall. The computers (about 15) within the temple are inter-connected through a high-speed LAN, through wireless and wired connections. A plasma screen is installed in the main temple to display the information about major events and special functions in the temple. The temple also has installed a state of the art PBX system to manage the ever-growing phone calls.

We look forward for your suggestions and cooperation in realizing this goal.
